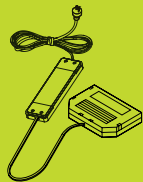

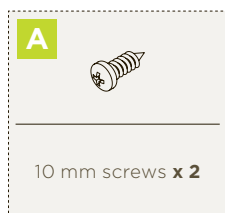

Things you need to know

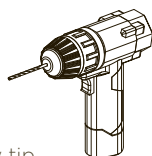
- When using an electrical appliance, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:
- Always read the instructions first before installation
- Not suitable for outdoor use
- Cut off the power source during the installation
- Don't bend the cables
- Keep proper ventilation around the unit and don't stack any objects on it.
- Keep 10-15 cm of clearance when the device is close to a heat source
- Check the information on the LED Driver label.
- **Please consider the total wattage of all lights being joined together and select the LED Driver that is greater than this total, taking into consideration the following:**
 - 15w = max load 13.5w
 - 30w = max load 27w
 - 75w = max load 67.5w

- **Caution:** Risk of electrical shock and energy hazard. If product fails to work, it should be examined by a qualified technician. Do not remove the case of the LED driver.
- Do not install LED Driver in places with high ambient temperature or close to fire source.
- Please refer to the specifications about the maximum ambient temperature limitations.
- Output current and output wattage must not exceed the rated values on the specifications
- If the LED Driver is damaged, the unit should be replaced.

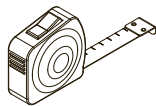
Tools you will need

Pencil

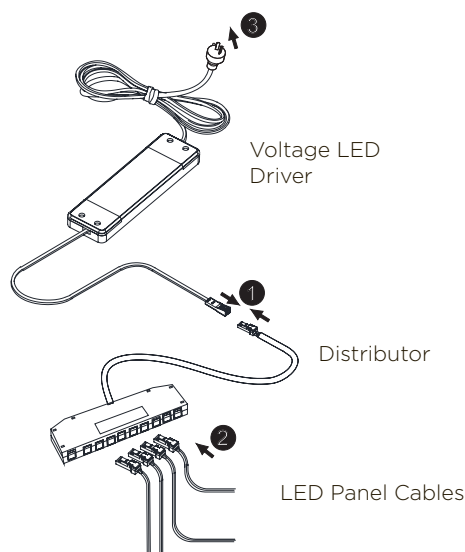

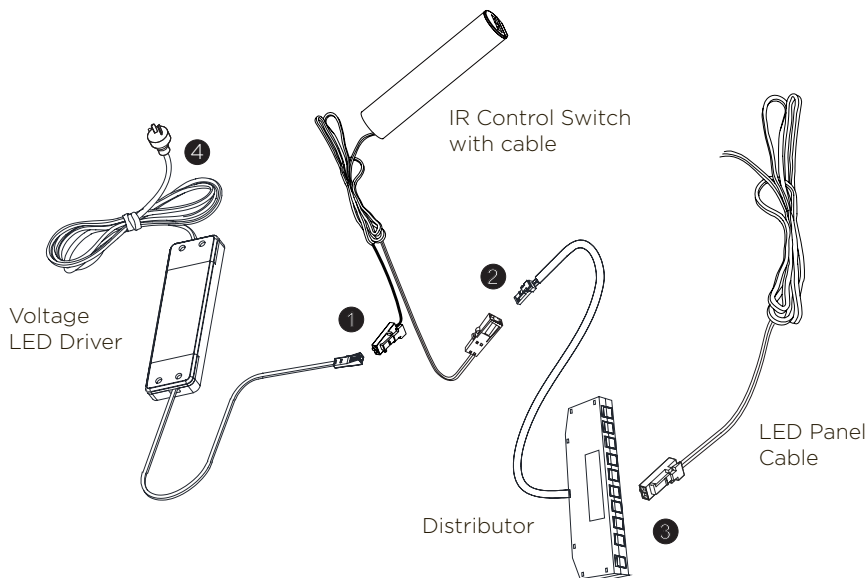
connecting LED Driver without IR Control Switch

1. Connect the **Voltage LED Driver** and the **Distributor**
2. Connect the **LED Panel Cable(s)** into the **Distributor**
3. Connect **Driver** to power source.



connecting LED Driver with IR Control Switch

1. Connect the **Voltage LED Driver** to the **IR Control Switch with cable**
2. Connect the **IR Control Switch with cable** to the **Distributor**
3. Connect the **Distributor** to the **LED Panel cable(s)**
4. Connect **Voltage LED Driver** into the power source
